Dr. Michael Huo is currently a Professor of Orthopedic Surgery at the University of Texas and is affiliated to the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery.

Dr. Huo is a member of a number of professional organisations including the American Association of Hip and Knee Surgeons, The Hip Society and the American Orthopedic Association. He contributes to a series of scientific journals including the *Journal of Arthroplasty*, the *Journal of Bone and Joint Surgery* and the *Journal of Clinical Orthopaedics and Related Research*. Dr. Huo has also been a member of the Writing Committee for the RE-MOBILIZE<sup>®</sup> trial, studying dabigatran etexilate in the prevention of venous thromboembolism after total knee replacement surgery.

During his career, Dr. Huo has received many honours and awards, and in 1991, was awarded the Otto Aufranc by The Hip Society, and in 2009, awarded the Outstanding Faculty Award at his current University.

Dr. Huo's special interest lies in total joint replacement surgery and in particular, revision joint replacement surgery, where he is currently involved in ongoing research in these areas.
