### The group of companies

Boehringer Ingelheim researches, develops, manufactures and markets medicines worldwide and is one of the world's 15 largest pharmaceutical companies.

#### Sites

- Ingelheim is the site for pharmaceutical production and sales in Germany as well as for the production of active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) for the worldwide group of companies. The global corporate headquarters is also located here.
- Biberach is the company's largest research campus worldwide and the biggest production site for pharmaceuticals manufactured using biotechnology.
- In Dortmund, Boehringer Ingelheim microParts GmbH develops, manufactures and sells products using micro-system technology.
- In Hanover, Boehringer Ingelheim is currently constructing a European research centre for animal vaccines that is due to be inaugurated at the end of 2011.

Boehringer Ingelheim, founded in 1885 by Albert Boehringer in Nieder-Ingelheim (part of the present-day Ingelheim), has since its beginning been family-owned and in 2010 celebrates its 125-year existence. The Shareholders' declared goal is for Boehringer Ingelheim to remain also in the future as an independent, family-owned company that grows organically.
