Dr. Oldgren completed his studies in Medicine at the Uppsala University, Sweden in 1989. He then proceeded to take up a post as intern at the Nyköping County Hospital, before moving into the role of resident doctor in Internal Medicine in 1991.

In 1994 he moved to Uppsala University hospital where he took on a role in the department of Cardiology, moving from a resident doctor to senior consultant and since 2002 Head of the Coronary Care Unit, as well working in clinical research. Since 2008 his roles have included senior teacher in the department of Medical Sciences and Senior Consultant / Head of Coronary Care Unit in the department of Cardiology.

Dr. Oldgren's special interests include coagulation activity, inflammation, risk stratification and antithrombotic treatment in acute coronary syndromes and atrial fibrillation. He has published several papers peer reviewed journals in this field and has also been investigator or co-investigator in several large-scale clinical trials, e.g. TRIM, FRISC II, ESTEEM, OASIS-5, OASIS-6, ExTRACT, APPRAISE, PLATO.

Most recently, Dr. Oldgren was the Swedish national coordinator of the phase III landmark RE-LY study, co-chairman in the global RE-LY AF registry and International co-ordinating investigator in the multi-national phase II RE-DEEM trial.
